



DISASTER SUPPLY KIT CHECKLIST

Disaster supply kits should include enough food, water, and other important items to last everyone in your household at least three days. Make sure it is portable in case of an evacuation.

PREPARING A DISASTER SUPPLY KIT

- ❖ Having a disaster supply kit ready to take with you at a moment's notice ensures that you will have necessary supplies no matter how fast you may need to evacuate. Pack supplies in large enough totes, duffle bags or backpacks and keep them in a designated place. Your kit will also come in handy if you must take shelter in your home.



Disasters can strike without warning, forcing you to go for days without basic necessities or to evacuate your home.

Knowing steps to take during a disaster, whether flooding, tornadoes, hurricanes or other disasters can greatly reduce the danger and distress your family may face.
